<b>Billecart Salmon Rosé – <i>Non Vintage</i></b> (12%, VN) Pale yet intensely pink in colour, pure, fresh and intense with lovely raspberry and citrus zest. # OFF THE BEATEN TRACK

Here we celebrate wines from lesser known places, the ‘Old World’ you seldom see.

## White

### Matošević Alba Antiqua

Croatia 2019 (13.5%, VN)

Made with native variety Malvazia Istarska this wine is only made in exceptional vintages this is aged for a phenomenal 30 months in French oak. Rich, woody, textured and full of apricots, acacia, honeyed notes and spice. A serious wine that needs to be drunk to be believed.

### Vulcao Ameixambar

Azores, 2021 (13%, BC, V)

The wine is bone dry, textural, mouth-filling and complex. It has flavours of lemon, pear and a touch of nuttiness, but its real character is the trademark minerality. Super long in the mouth, leaving you wanting another glass. Only a few thousand bottles are made of this unique wine from a rare winemaking region, with a pure oceanic soul.

### Zorah Chilar

Armenia 2021 (13.5%, OP, VN)

The nose boasts fresh pear and stone fruit aromas, particularly peach and apricot. There is a harmonious depth to the palate, with nutty and creamy notes which leads to a long finish. An incredible example of native Armenian grapes and tradition. A must try.

## Rose

### Ibizkus Totem

Spain 2020 (12.4%, OP, VN)

From some of the oldest vines in Ibiza. Hand picked fruit combined with wild yeast fermentation in first and second use French oak and lees ageing produces one of the most gastronomic rose´ wines we have tried. Aromas of ripe cherries, red berries, and herbs stand out whilst the smooth texture and mouthwatering acidity playfully entwine. A truly exciting and unique wine.

## Red

### Bedoba Saperavi

Kakheti, Georgia 2022 (13.5%, OP, VN)

Made from the indigenous grape variety Saperavi and partially vinified in traditional qvevri vessels, Bedoba means ‘Day of Luck’. This wine is dark and inky while the nose is a powerful savoury-spicy bouquet of blackberries, herbs and black pepper. The palate has a juicy texture, ripe tannins and black fruit flavours.

### Zorah ‘Karasi’ Areni Noir

Armenia 2022 (14%, OP, VN)

From one of the oldest winemaking regions dating back over 6000 years. This Armenian native variety, Areni, thrives at high altitude. This wine boasts aromas of spiced red and dark berries with subtle hints of toast. On the palate, rich fruit flavours are interwoven with smooth, mature tannins and a sprightly acidity that lingers on the lengthy finish.

### Dalia Splet Gamay/ Vranac

Serbia 2022 (14%, OP, VN)

Kristina Lukic works a small 9 hectare vineyard in the heart of Timok. Deep ruby with hints of purple in colour, this Gamay and Vranac blend displays aromas of dark cherry and liquorice, with a hint of earthy notes. On the palate, the wine is medium bodied, with elegant acidity and fine tannins.
